Thought for the Week 29th May

When I wear one of my jackets for Sunday worship, I try and remember to wear a buttonhole badge. Two of them are from when we celebrated Arthur and Bertram's first birthdays. Another was a gift from the Charles family as I had the joy of conducting Jo and Ed's wedding. The fourth one is a badge I have worn more times than I care to remember; it is my Boys' Brigade buttonhole badge.

I searched high and low for it recently because I went to the funeral of my former BB Captain and when I joined BB, I was given a buttonhole badge because it was part of the uniform. The BB badge

is made up of a cross and an anchor because BB's motto, 'Sure and Steadfast', comes from Hebrews 6 verse 19 which speaks of being anchored safely in the love and the promises of God in Christ.

I joined BB, when I was 11 and when I think of Mr Kennett, who was the Captain, I think of someone who not only lived and breathed BB, but of someone who personified it. What I mean by this is that he was someone who lived a life rooted and grounded in Jesus.
