Thought for the Week 12th June

A small word with a big meaning.

Like many others I am very grateful to Andy Evers for the Everyday Supernatural course which he delivered brilliantly and I feel that it is helping me to draw closer to God in all aspects of my life. Reflecting back over the weeks I keep coming back to that little word "with".

Learning to live more in a relationship *with* God, leaning into him, and relearning the truth that being *with* God is even more important than what I do *for* God because, *with* God, everything is possible. I need to hold onto that knowledge through thick and thin.

Learning to pray more *with* people not just for people, this is actually two "withs" as I know that I will only be effective if I am praying *with* God in the power of the Spirit and *with* the person I am praying for. Being truly *with* someone involves heart mind and emotions and not allowing other distractions to disturb us.

Quality time is "*with*" time, generously giving of ourselves and living in the moment and is something I need to work on as it is so easy to be distracted in our busy lives and all the crazy stuff going on in our world around us.

And "*standing with*" someone means wholehearted commitment to a person and /or a cause which in some cases means putting ourselves in personal danger. When we stand *with Jesus*, we make a public commitment and we allow God to work through us by his Holy Spirit. Jesus was always clear that he was *with* God and God was *with* him and he in turn calls us into the same relationship.

"If you remain in me and my words remain in you, **ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.** This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples" (John 15.7)

Jesus told us clearly what we must do to bear much fruit and this has been wonderfully reinforced in recent teaching from both Andys. **Ed Tomlinson**
