'Thought for the Week'

'Let us make human beings in our image.' Genesis 1 verse 26

By the time you've read this the first part of our discussing the question of human sexuality will have finished and this will be repeated on Friday. As I said in the email that came out this week, Session One is called 'In the Beginning' and this will focus on the sheer awe and wonder of who we are as complex people in the sight of God. Session Two, called 'I am a New Creation' will explore further our identity in Christ and how this impacts our sexuality.

The Psalmist in Psalm 139 speaks of us as being fearfully and wonderfully made and Genesis echoes this by describing us as being made in the Image of God. For me this is one of the most incredible things the Bible says about us.

The metaphor asks us to imagine ourselves as being like an idol or image you would find in a Temple. The point of an image is to say that we are a complete representation of who our God is. Yet there is more to this then that. We not only represent who God is, God wishes to dwell in us by his Spirit as he dwelt in his Son. This is why I find discussing the question of human sexuality so intriguing.

Though this is a red-hot topic today, we come to discuss it as those who are all made in the Image of God. Thus, we come with humility because there is always so much more to learn and we come with grace that we may learn this from each other. Above all, we come to this theme with love in our hearts and minds since it is because of love we were made and it is for love that we are to live.

We are made in the Image of God and our hope is that we will be remade in the Image of Christ. May these truths animate and help us in all our conversations.
