# Thought for the week From Alison Bygrave

It is that time of the year when we make New Year resolutions, we have a new Church Text, and lots of good intentions. It may be that by the time you are reading this the resolution is already forgotten or abandoned, or maybe you are someone who doesn't even make one for fear of failing.

The great thing is with God you don't have to be afraid of failing or of not keeping resolutions. There is a rather (to me) intriguing passage in Matthew 5 which reads

<sup>33</sup> "Again, you have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'Do not break your oath, but fulfil to the Lord the vows you have made.' <sup>34</sup> But I tell you, do not swear an oath at all: either by heaven, for it is God's throne; <sup>35</sup> or by the earth, for it is his footstool; or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the Great King. <sup>36</sup> And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make even one hair white or black. <sup>37</sup> All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one. <sup>[g]</sup>

So, we shouldn't make promises or plans which we can't keep or try to move forward in directions which might seem 'godly' but aren't in God's future for us. As it says in James 4:15 - Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."

Which brings me to the Church Text for the coming year. I didn't know what it was when I started writing this but I sent an email and, while I was typing, the reply came
