#### **Thought for the Week**

#### I'm slipping!

In today's Word Live Tony Horsfall said "one day it dawned on me that it was not my ability to trust God that mattered, but the fact that He is trustworthy" and off my thoughts went again.

How often do we beat ourselves up because we think we are losing our trust in God? Life grinds us down. All we can see is the problem. All we experience is the emotional pain. Life looks very bleak with no light at the end of the tunnel we feel in. Sharing what's going on with family or friends, especially Christians, becomes nigh on impossible. We feel isolated and cut off.

We need to paraphrase what Tony said God is trustworthy - fact! Thankfully once we have established that relationship with God through Jesus how we feel each day isn't what's critical. What is important and life changing is that God is totally, absolutely, infinitely trustworthy.

An image I've found helpful is the simple image of 2 hands holding each other by the wrist. Holding by the wrist is the most secure way of connecting two people. It's also a good image of the strength of your relationship with God once you've brought Jesus intentionally into your life. The relationship is secure.

Imagine you're up to your neck in water (or let's call it sin - the real world we live in day by day). You are holding God's arm in this way and He is holding yours.

God will never let go - He is trustworthy. You might loosen your grip or even slip up and try to let go but as long as God holds onto you then you are safe - He is trustworthy. You might bob under the water (do something you later regret and need forgiveness from God for). As long as God has hold of you then you are being pulled out of the water - out of the sin. God is there with you by His grip on you - He is trustworthy. You might panic and thrash about in the water - you might feel totally overwhelmed by your situation but nothing can break the hold God has on you - He is trustworthy. You might feel you are slipping away from God we are often our own worst critics and go straight to catastrophising situations - because the water seems so overpowering but God has hold of you and ..... He is trustworthy.

Be reassured, once you have given your life to God it's a one way trip no matter how you feel day by day in the roller coaster of life. God does not change (Hebrews 13:8), God will not abandon you - whatever (Hebrews 13:5), His promises are eternal (Psalm 119:89), you are safe in His grip (Psalm 121) - God is trustworthy.
