### **Thought for the Week**

### **The Quiet Time**

Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. I say to myself, "The Lord is my portion; therefore, I will wait for him." The Lord is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him; it is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord.

Lamentations 3:23-26

I am thinking today about the spiritual discipline which some people call a 'quiet time'. I know this is crucial to our walk with God but I confess that sometimes I just get, dare I say, bored with doing the same thing. I need to stimulate my mind in different ways. For a while I study the weekly readings from the notice sheet; in the past I have used Every Day with Jesus and The Bible in One Year. I wondered am I wrong to want different things. Then God who keeps highlighting verses from his word brought these from Lamentations to verses especially, 'His compassions are new every morning'. I heard them not just from one direction but from the Bible app and Lectio 365, and the passage was read at church, and someone mentioned it in passing. God's love and compassions are new every morning. Maybe he wants me to approach him in a different way from time to time. He is faithful so I can wait to see what new things he shows me each day. If I am waiting quietly for his salvation, it doesn't matter how I approach him and his word. The important thing is to do it, to come to his word each day no matter what method I and to remember his love. compassion, faithfulness, goodness and Alison Bygrave salvation.
