

Thought for the Week

God's Gifts

About three weeks ago, I was cleaning up some plant pots in the garden. I lifted up the stack of pots, and one fell to the ground and inside sat a little baby bird. I don't know who was more surprised - the bird or me! As I watched and wondered what to do, I looked at this fluffy little creature, standing like a statue with its chest going up and down in fear. Suddenly, it popped onto the top of the plant pot and ran across the grass, before disappearing behind the bins into a crack between the two garden fences. How on earth was the mother going to find her baby? Praying that if I cleared a way for the mother to see her baby she would come and get it, I set about moving the bins and cutting part of the fence down to enable that to happen but each time I revealed what I thought was a path to freedom for the baby bird and access for the mother, the little bird would move into a deeper position, creating yet another barrier which I then had to cut away. Why could this little bird not understand that I was trying to help it? I left it alone once I could see a clear space and prayed the mother would come. I was in and out of the garden and getting quite agitated about this baby bird. Eventually after about three hours the bird had gone. I do like happy endings - so in my mind the mother did find her baby.

I tell this story, because as I was praying about what I should write about here, the picture of that little bird hiding behind things that denied freedom, made me think about the goodness of God and how he wants us to be free in Him - free in Him to serve, to walk with Him and learn of Him..... but sometimes we put up our own fences and prevent ourselves from receiving all that God has to give. He is our father and wants what is best for us. He wants us to receive the gifts He has for us – gifts that money cannot buy.

The gift of peace that can withstand the trials that life will place in our way

The gift of joy that bubbles up and cannot be contained

The gift of love that has no limits

The gift of being filled with His Holy Spirit

His Holy Spirit takes us into a deeper and closer walk with him. I ask myself the same question as I ask you, "Are there fences or barriers in your life, like the little bird, that stop God from giving you his very best?"

James 1 v 17 reads: "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows"
