#### **DESCRIPTION**

#### Intro:

- Yesterday I had the absolute privilege to baptise my father.
- He has been a believer for many years, but now in his old age, the Spirit of God has brought him to the understanding that this **step of obedience** is important.
- What a glorious celebration to enter into a covenant with Yahweh.
- And the best part of that is we are adopted into the family of God.
- Just like Jesus when we are baptised and come up out of that water our Heavenly Father says to us: "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." (Matt 3:16-17)
- This just reminded me again of the fact that we are who God says we are.
- You are not who other people say you are,
- You are not even who you say you are!
- Only the one who created you has the right and the authority to say who you are!
- And I want to remind you of what <u>Jesus says about you</u>...
- you are not defined by your **past**
- you are not defined by your **behaviours**
- you are not defined by your failures
- you are not defined by your **struggles**
- you are not defined by your feelings
- you are not defined by your **circumstances**
- you are not defined by the here today gone tomorrow false ideologies and water-down philosophies of **our current culture**
- you are who God says you are!
- it doesn't matter what others say about you
- it doesn't even matter what you have chosen to say about yourself
- there's only one who has the authority to say who you truly are...
- the one **who gave life** to you
- others aren't qualified!
- your **circumstances** aren't powerful enough to Define you
- your story may have hurt you, but it does not shape the totality of who you are
- YOU ARE WHO GOD SAYS YOU ARE...
- and he says you are a **chosen race**
- you are a royal priesthood
- you are redeemed, chosen, adopted and qualified.
- you are <u>not a mistake</u>
- you are <u>not an afterthought</u>
- you are <u>not a liability</u>
- you are a temple of the Holy Spirit of God
- the value God has placed on you in Christ means you are enough!
- GOD LOVES YOU!

- <u>He made you in His image</u> both **physically** and in your **personality** the strengths and the weaknesses all of it <u>is an expression of the creative genius of almighty God</u>
- when you **surrender your whole self fully and completely to Him**, He <u>takes up residence</u> in you he <u>makes you His dwelling place</u>, so you become <u>a temple of almighty God</u>.
- You are everything you need to be in Christ Jesus.
- That is who you are!!!

# Why is it important to know what God says about us?

- because <u>how we live our lives</u> is in **direct correlation** to <u>what we believe</u> about ourselves.
- We need to allow Jesus to reset our beliefs so that we can live according to what He says about us.
- We were called into the Kingdom and given a new identity and purpose.
- However, over time we sometimes lose sight of what it is all about...
- Of what it means to be a Christian?

### What is Christianity?

- The Encyclopaedia Britannica defines it as:
  - **Christianity** is a major <u>religion</u> stemming from the life, teachings, and death of <u>Jesus of Nazareth</u> (the Christ, or the Anointed One of God) in the 1st century CE. It has become the largest of the world's religions and, geographically, the most widely diffused of all faiths. It has a <u>constituency</u> of more than two billion believers.
- When it comes to Christianity there are so many viewpoints that one struggles to pinpoint what it is all about.
- Some of us have been Christians for a long time and are actively involved in church
- Over the years we have learned a great deal and attended many conferences and retreats.
- We have read many books.
- However, we seem to have lost touch with what it is all about.
- So let us dig a little deeper:

# Christians on Christianity:

#### • Billy Graham

"Being a Christian is more than just an instantaneous conversion – it is a daily process whereby you grow to be more and more like Christ."

#### • C. S. Lewis

"The Christian does not think God will love us because we are good, but that God will make us good because He loves us."

#### • A.W. Tozer

"If I see aright, the cross of popular evangelicalism is not the cross of the New Testament. It is, rather, a new bright ornament upon the bosom of a self-assured and carnal Christianity. The old cross slew men, the new cross entertains them. The old cross condemned; the new cross amuses. The old cross destroyed confidence in the flesh; the new cross encourages it."

"There is a common, worldly kind of Christianity in this day, which many have, and think they have enough – a cheap Christianity which **offends** nobody and requires no **sacrifice** – which **costs** nothing and is **worth** nothing."

# Why is the Gospel Offensive?

- What is the Christian confession? = Jesus is LORD!
- the Bible teaches us that no one can say that except by the Holy Spirit.
- This does not refer to physically saying the words, but to the spiritual act of bowing the knee to Jesus Christ.
- WHY?
- Because to be able to understand what that means and live accordingly is a spiritual thing.
- That is why the teaching of non-lordship Salvation is so detrimental
- It is the idea that you can say I believe in Jesus without bowing the knee to him as Lord!
- No Christians had ever come up with that idea before.
- The reason that **Christians died** in droves under **Roman persecution** is because they didn't believe what is taught so often today in many so-called Christian churches.
- Because it's a radical claim
- it is offensive to the world system
- and it is certainly offensive to the secular world around us...
- You will be mocked if you not only **believe that Jesus is LORD**,
- but live according to the idea that a backwards Galilean itinerant preacher in the first century who never wrote a book, who didn't even travel to Rome the great city of his day or Athens the great philosophical Center...
- that He is actually the creator of this entire universe
- and by **His power holds** all of that vast universe together
- You've got to be kidding!
- That **is offensive** to any thinking person.
- The **Cross** to them that are perishing is foolishness (1 Corinthians 1:18)
- from the perspective of the wisdom of the world this is ridiculous
- how can you ask anyone to believe this?
- AND all these programs and movements the church has come up with to try
  to make the gospel acceptable to people only result in something other than
  the Gospel.
- because for the gospel to be the gospel it must be offensive
- it has to be that **stone which crushes and breaks** before there can be healing and regeneration
- The very message which to those who are perishing is foolishness is those who are being saved the very power of God!
- Jesus has not chosen to use the Elite of the world BUT the foolish and weak
- so that he might demonstrate the foolishness of the things that are.
- That was the whole point!
- You see God chooses in his Mercy to raise them to spiritual life...
- to open their understandings that they might see His glory
  - o as Creator
  - o as Saviour
  - o as the way, and the truth, and the life

- but you see that takes a spiritual activity in the heart and the mind
- and if we no longer trust the **tools** that have been **given to the church** in the <u>gospel</u> and the <u>Spirit of God</u>
- then we are always going to be looking for something else to try to basically trick people into a **non-offensive counterfeit Gospel**.
- The gospel is offensive to anyone who has not bowed the knee to Jesus Christ
- and it needs to remain that way to be the gospel!
- And this is what we have been called to present to the world!
- Now the question is how do we do that?

#### Sacrifice:

- The sacrifice is <u>putting me</u>, <u>myself and I on the altar</u> and **living in LOVE**.
- **Love God** with all your <u>heart</u> and with all your <u>soul</u> and with all your <u>mind</u> and with all your <u>strength</u> and your <u>neighbour as yourself!</u>
- The measure of the **love of Jesus** is just amazing....
  - He loves us within our brokenness
  - He has grace for us within our ignorance
  - He has mercy for us despite our **disobedience**.
- He is the perfect example of Love
- and he <u>calls us to love</u> the same way...
- It comes down to a life of total surrender to Jesus Christ as Lord in every area of our lives.
- The fruit of *this* is **love** for each other
- The fruit of *this* is **body** of Christ
- The fruit of *this* is **light** of the world
- The fruit of *this* is the building of the **Kingdom** of God.

#### Cost:

- Christianity is about the **glorification of the beloved Son of God.**
- About **submitting to Him and following Him**, even if it costs you your life.
- It is in that place that we find salvation, empowerment, and the gifts and fruit of the Holy Spirit.
- Christianity is about **Christ** not about <u>you and me</u> or our <u>church</u> <u>denomination</u> or our <u>outreach initiatives</u> or anything else we do.
- Because all that will be meaningless without HIM!!

#### Worth:

- Even though Corinth is not specifically mentioned among the seven congregations in Revelations, many Theologians believe that God selected these seven congregations to give **timeless instruction** for His people **throughout the centuries**.
- Because this instruction is both **historical and prophetic**.
- John was told to write about "the things which *are*, and the things which *will* take place after this" (verse 19)
- Here we see the example of the church in Ephesus.
- This Church was **healthy and vibrant** when Paul first wrote to them.
- It is now **30 years later**, and Paul has passed away and probably many of their original leaders who knew him.
- **Jesus dictates** a letter to them, acknowledges their wonderful works, and sees their effort, BUT he is clear... **they missed it!**

- They have missed what it is about...
- They have made it about their <u>worship</u> and <u>the experiences they have</u> in their Services.
- They have made it about manifestations and appearing anointed.
- **Jesus says repent** or I will come to you and <u>take the lampstand from your midst</u> the lampstand symbolises God's presence with them.
- If we do not hear this, we will gather as a church but will not be a **church of God** anymore.
- I think often we do not mean for this to happen; we just lose focus and forget what it is all about and who our Lord Jesus is...
- That He is the BELOVED OF GOD and that everything centres around Him.
- Jesus is the **focus of God the Father** and the reason for everything.
- Jesus is the reason for creation.
- In terms of Salvation, he is the **lamb**, the **high priest**, and the **way** to God.

### Pricilla Shirer:

- He is the **first** and the **last**
- The **beginning** and the **end**
- He is the keeper of creation and the creator of all
- He is the architect of the universe
- He is the manager of all time
- He always was... always is... and always will be...
  - Unmoved
  - Unchanged
  - Undefeated
  - And never undone
- He was **bruised** but brought **healing**
- He was pierced but eased pain
- He was **persecuted** but brought **freedom**
- He was dead and brings life
- He has **risen** to bring **power**

- His word is eternal
- His will is unchanging
- And His mind is on us
- He is
  - Our saviour
  - o Our **guide**
  - Our peace
  - Our joy
  - Our Comfort
  - o Our **Lord**
- And He rules our lives
- I serve Him because:
  - His bond is love
    - His yolk is easy
    - His burden is light
    - And His goal for us is abundant life
- I follow him because:
  - He is the wisdom of the wise
  - The Power of the powerful
  - The ancient of days
  - The ruler of rulers
  - The leader of all leaders
  - His goal is a relationship with us
- He will...
  - o never **leave** us nor **forsake** us
  - Never Mislead us
  - Never foraet us
  - Never overlook us
- And **never cancel your appointment** in His appointment book
- When we fall, He will lift us up
- When we **fail**, He will forgive us
- When we are **weak**, He is **strong**
- When we are **lost**, He is **our way**
- When we are **afraid**, He is our **courage**
- When we stumble, He will steady us

- When we are **hungry**, He will **feed** us
