#### **Thought for the Week**

My cousin, who attends a church in Hertfordshire, sent me this earlier this month. I have permission to share it with you. An amazing story of encouragement, of how God works in the lives of everyone. I'm using her words ...

We had a baptism at church last night. It was such a special occasion.

One, an adult man, whose testimony was filled with conviction and assurance. The other was Harvey, almost 18 years old, autistic and nonverbal. He'd made it clear to his mum that he wanted to be baptised. To cut a long story short, she was concerned that his testimony was his words not hers. Someone suggested that he use pictures as he draws a lot. The trouble was that he copies pictures, he can't do them from his head. His sister is artistic and was given the task of trying, with Harvey, to get a picture of his testimony.

Time went on and nothing happened. A week or so before the date of the baptism his mum said to Harvey, 'Harvey, you have to show me why you love Jesus and want to be baptised.' He said yes and went upstairs while she went shopping. When she came home, he ran downstairs and showed her what he'd done. It was a beautifully coloured, shaped border and, in large writing across the centre, he had written,

'His mercy rescues me'

Wow! He read it at his baptismal service, with his mum. There wasn't anyone there who wasn't moved. God is good. No-one is outside of His reach. Alison S
