# **Domino Effect - A Manifesto that's Different**

In today's reading notes (Bible in One Year) I was reminded that as Christians we have a manifesto. Manifestos are produced whenever there's a democratic Election and all the parties declare their position and promises. When Jesus attended the synagogue in Nazareth He was handed the scroll of Isaiah and read from chapter 61 a manifesto declaring "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." Luke 4:21 NIVUK. So, what is Jesus' manifesto - our manifesto? How can we champion it? Not for the first time daily readings made me think - funnily enough about a row of stacked dominoes and what happens when you knock one over.

1. Lives will be transformed when you intentionally want a relationship with God through Jesus. People will change

- as the Holy Spirit helps them to be more like Jesus. (Galatians 5:22-26 and our church membership commitment -Engaging more with Jesus). If you intentionally engage more with Jesus it has consequences.
- 2. Values will be transformed. Our values will change what we support, what we watch, what we champion. What we value when we shop, the government we choose, the value we place on what the media tell us, what we do for entertainment. Our attitude towards others will be seen in our use of wealth, how it's created, how we support the poor and the vulnerable. Transformed values will be seen in how we live our lives.
- 3. Relationships will be transformed. We will begin to see people in a different light. God loves all people without distinction all are sinners and all need Jesus. Within a church fellowship, our family, our friends, people we bump into we will begin to see them as God does and love them. Our attitude to them will change (church membership commitment Enabling others to meet Jesus). Transformed relationships will impact our communities
- 4. Communities will be transformed. Whether it's your neighbours, your street or your village or town as you seek to enrich your community, they will all become transformed or Enriched (church membership commitment -Enriching our communities). Transformed communities will change society.

Transformation is the key word throughout. Loving Jesus and living for Him and through Him is transformational - once committed to it we can never be the same. Our commitments change, our values are changed, relationships are reworked, and, our communities change. We may not be the SAS but their motto is sound "Who dares Wins".
