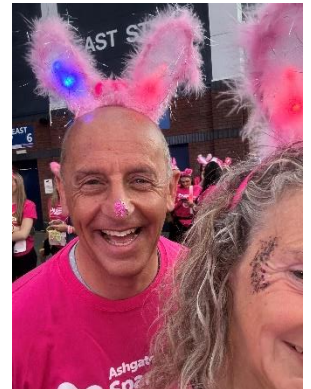

Thought for the Week

Pentecost

Acts 2 is a favourite chapter of mine in the Bible. The Apostles saw what the all-powerful religious and Roman authorities did to anyone who challenged their authority and they rightly feared for their lives. They were most likely confused and very frightened, Jesus had gone but had told them to wait for the Holy Spirit. Maybe they did this with mixed emotions, wanting to believe but scared to go out and about as normal.

Then it happened, the Holy Spirit came with more power than they could ever have imagined, the timid apostles became fearless lions for Christ and thousands gave their lives to Christ immediately. Christian faith grew against all the odds; it survived and flourished as political empires came and went. Christianity became the official faith of the Roman Empire which tried to snuff it out.

For me this is the ultimate proof that Jesus is alive, he is the son of God and when we believe we can have the power of the Holy Spirit living in us.

What can we learn from this?

Listen and Obey – Jesus told them to wait in Jerusalem for the Holy Spirit and they did.

Build our relationship with Jesus through prayer and worship so that we are open to the spirit,

Speak up for Jesus and justice, no fear, the Holy Spirit will give us the words

Don't worry about our imperfections, his strength is made perfect in our weakness.

I sometimes look at our world, at existential wars raging on our doorstep, religious and secular hatred on the streets around us, at the steady erosion of freedoms and the regrowth of controlling societies, at greed and injustice and the coming tsunami of Artificial Intelligence based control and genetic engineering.

When this makes me afraid, I know that I need to cling to the rock that is Jesus and pray that the Holy Spirit will work through me and continue telling others of the love and peace that can be found in Jesus.
