

Lent

Our course for Lent this year is Lectio Divina. It's an ancient tradition and being so it's a simple way of drawing close to God's word and hearing Him speak through it.

It's a Latin phrase which simply means reading God's word in a prayerful, meditative way. It's all about slowing down and taking your time.

It's not about how much Bible knowledge we have but rather about immersing yourself in the passage you are reading, put yourself in the story or situation, be part of what Jesus is teaching.


The main verse is Luke 24 v 32.

Were not our hearts burning within us while He talked with us on the road and opened the scriptures to us.

The road to Emmaus, Jesus walked and talked with his companions, Cleopas and an unnamed person (why can't that be you or me) and explained the scriptures to them, and they didn't realise it was him until later.

That's what Jesus wants to do with you and me, He wants to walk and talk to us, to chat to us and explain and enlighten us.
